

PURPOSE / ISSUE

The Toxicology Section at the Centre of Forensic Sciences (CFS) has developed a **standardized urine drug testing kit** for use with individuals who allege non-consensual drugging.

CFS will supply kits at no cost on an ongoing basis. Additional kits can be ordered through the CFS website ([Submit evidence to the Centre of Forensic Sciences | ontario.ca](https://submit.evidence.to.the.centre.of.forensic.sciences.ontario.ca)) or by emailing the request to jus.g.msg.pubsd.cfs.crorequests@ontario.ca.

Kit Contents:

The **Administration of Noxious Substance Kit** includes:

- Urine collection container with continuity seals
- A transfer pipette
- Instructions for hospital staff and police
- Consent forms
- Questionnaire / drug testing form
- (All documents are provided in **English and French**)

Usage:

- The kit may be completed by any clinician; involvement of a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) is not required.
- Only police services are authorized to submit samples to the Centre of Forensic Sciences (CFS). Hospitals must not send samples directly to CFS.
- Hospitals may perform their own clinical toxicology testing if a patient chooses not to involve police. Patients should be informed that:
 - Hospital test results may not be admissible in court.
 - Clinical toxicology screens may be less comprehensive than CFS testing.
- The kit **does not expire**
