CFS Firearms Unit - Submission Packaging Guidelines for SFI and RAISE Cases

SFI Cases: Agency Generated Test Fires (TFs)

- TFs (cartridge cases & bullets or shotshells) from one firearm are to be placed in a resealable plastic bag, which is placed in a bubble envelope. Please do not seal the bubble envelope.
- > One set of TFs per envelope with "Test Fires" label applied to the front.
- ➤ The bubble envelope(s) can then be placed in a sealed property bag.

The following fields are completed by the submitting agency:

- Agency Occurrence Number
- > Date firearm was seized/recovered
- Make/Model/Action/Type/Calibre of the firearm
- Serial Number of firearm
 - If no serial number please put NONE, if removed please put OBLITERATED, if unknown please put UNKNOWN

RAISE Cases: Exhibits (Scene Items)

- Each item is to be placed in its own resealable plastic bag, labelled with an exhibit number
- Cartridge Cases:
 - All cartridge cases with the same calibre can be placed in one bubble envelope.
 Please do not seal the bubble envelope.
 - o Each bubble envelope will need an 'Exhibit Items' label applied to the front
- Projectiles (only if cartridge cases haven't been recovered or submitted):
 - Place plastic bags containing projectiles into one bubble envelope
 - o Apply "Exhibit Items" Label leaving the calibre field blank

The following fields are completed by the submitting agency:

- > Agency Occurrence Number & Occurrence Date
- Calibre of cartridge cases ONLY (if known, i.e. on headstamp)
- > Number of cartridge cases or projectiles

The following (or comparable) specifications are recommended for packaging: 2 x 3" or 2 Mil Resealable Bags -- these are typically used for handgun and small rifle rounds 4 x 6" or 2 Mil Resealable Bags -- these are typically used for shotshells and revolver rounds 4 x 8" bubble envelopes

NOTE: It is important to note that the gold bubble envelopes must be 4" x 8" as this packaging is used for long term storage at CFS. The gold bubble envelopes are **not** to be sealed when sending the items to us. Simply place the open envelope into a sealed property bag.
